

CAMP PACKING LIST

Please be sure to bring the following items:

CLOTHING

- Pants and jeans
- Shorts (see dress code)
- T-shirts and hoodies
- Bathing suit
- Socks and undergarments
- Summer hat or cap
- Sunglasses if you use them
- Running shoes (no sandals or flip flops to be worn during activities, but may be used for water activities)
- Jacket
- Rain gear rubber boots, waterproof jacket
- Warm pajamas

SLEEPING GEAR

- Sleeping bag and blankets (Alberta nights can be cool even in July)
- Pillow
- Mattress/foamie/camp cot
- Flashlight

DISHES

All attendees will be responsible for washing their own dishes after each meal. Dishes are to be kept in a **mesh bag** (like a laundry bag) and hung on a clothesline to air dry.

Please bring plastic or tin - no glass.

Label each dish and utensil with your name.

- Plate
- Bowl
- Glass and/or cup
- Fork, Knife, and Spoon

OTHER GEAR

- Life Jacket for canoeing and water tubing
- Bath towel
- Water bottle with your name on it
- Sunscreen (bug spray is provided)
- Any prescribed medications you need (please see notes on medicine at camp on Camp Information Page)
- A Bible
- Bathroom essentials toothpaste, toothbrush, hairbrush, soap, shampoo, etc.
- Washcloth

**Camp Wildrose has 2 outdoor washrooms with regular flushing toilets and running water at the sink. One building has 2 showers.

Electronics

• There are NO electronics of any kind permitted at Camp Wildrose. Possession of such will result in confiscation for the duration of camp.

Dress Code

Boys

- Hair must be short and trimmed.
- Shirts must cover the torso and pants cannot hang below the waist.
- Undergarments cannot be seen.
- Slogans and pictures on clothing must be church camp appropriate.
- Swim trunks or board shorts are permissible for water sports.
- No body piercings (piercings will need to be removed prior to camp)
- No tattoos (if camper does have a tattoo it should be covered if possible)

Girls

- Shirts must cover the torso. Bellybutton cannot be seen. Also, cannot be low cut and showing cleavage. Spaghetti strap tank tops are not permissible.
- Shorts must come to mid- thigh or lower. NO short shorts.
- Swimsuits must cover the belly and be of a decent cut. No bikinis. Tankinis or one-piece suits are permissible for water sports.
- Slogans and pictures on clothing must be church camp appropriate.
- No body piercings other than earrings (body piercings will need to be removed prior to camp)
- No tattoos (if camper does have a tattoo it should be covered if possible)
